

C5 Low Temperature Physics:

Final meeting held on August 9, 2008 in Amsterdam. Matters discussed included the IUPAP Young Scientist Prize in Low Temperature Physics, the London Prize and Simon Prize. Four conferences were sponsored by the commission. A Type A conference: the 25th International Conference on Low Temperature Physics (LT25) held in August 6-13, 2008 in Amsterdam where over 1400 participants attended from nearly 50 countries, two type B conferences: the International Symposium on Quantum Fluids QFS 2007 held in Kazan, Russia on August 1-5, 2007 attended by 206 participants from 15 countries and QFS 2006 held in Kyoto, Japan, attended by 255 participants from 18 countries. A type C conference, the 7th Conference on Cryocrystals and Quantum Crystals held in Wroclaw, Poland in July 31-August 5, 2008. First IUPAP Young Scientist prizes in low temperature physics awarded to three recipients at LT25 conference in August 2008. The recipients were Dr Dai Aoki from CEA-Grenoble, France, Dr Kostya Novoselov from University of Manchester, UK, and Dr Viktor Tsepelin from Lancaster University, UK.
